#### **Two-Sided Printing Saves Paper** by Kathy Watson



The California Genealogical Society has purchased two Dell 3330dn printers which deliver high-performance printing of up to forty pages per minute and up to 80,000 pages per month. Patrons and volunteers will wait less time for printouts and can spend more time on productive work. The Dell 3330dn prints both text and business graphics with crystal clarity.

The new printers were purchased at discount from Dell and support both the use of recycled paper and the re-use of freshly printed paper. "N-Up" multiplesheet printing reduces paper consumption by allowing the printing of multiple pages on a single sheet of paper. Two-sided printing is also an option and has been chosen as the default configuration at the library.



My paternal grandmother graces the cover of my book China Connection: Finding Ancestral Roots For Chinese in America. Her name is lost to us and I only know her by her husband's surname. The photograph was a gift from my mother who told me Grandma Fung lived in China all of her life, working in the silk farming industry harvesting mulberry

leaves for the silkworms. The original photograph appears to have been taken in the early 1900s. In it she wears a classic hair-do for that period for a woman her age. I understand that she died at about 90 years of age, so I approximate her dates to be about 1885 - 1975.
